A LOOK BACK ON OUR EVENTS

CIRANO co-organized a conference on the issues and opportunities confronting the food industry that was attended by 150 representatives from this sector



On February 1st, 2018, 150 representatives of the Agri-food industry (from producers to retailers and restaurateurs) joined with researchers in a high-level conference designed to shed some light on what the future holds.

Jointly organized by CIRANO and NSF International in collaboration with the Conseil de la transformation alimentaire du Québec (CTAQ), this conference also provided a forum for several of CIRANO's researchers to present their current work. JoAnne Labrecque (HEC Montreal) presented her results on the disruptions eCommerce has brought to the food industry and Ingrid Peignier (CIRANO) talked about some initial results from a study of the value of food certification.
